## Finding Articles

1. Use periodical indexes & abstracts for current research (Choose Articles from Library web).
2. If article is not available in the index you are searching:
  - a. Check **Full Text Journal Finder** book or search the **SUU Library Catalog** to see if the periodical is in the SUU Library.
  - b. Check **Full Text Journal Finder** link to see if journal is available in another database.
  - c. If article is still not available request it through UTAD (Utah Article Delivery).

## Journal Indexes, Abstracts and Full Text

### EBSCOhost databases:

#### **PsycINFO**

Contains citations and summaries (no full text) of journal articles, book chapters, books, and technical reports, as well as citations to dissertations, all in the field of psychology and psychological aspects of related disciplines. Abstracts can be downloaded, printed, or emailed. For full text check SUU Holdings or Electronic Journals.

#### **Academic Search Elite**

Full text for 1,700+ journals in the social sciences, humanities, general science, multi-cultural studies, education, and much more.

#### **MEDLINE**

Abstract index of authoritative medical information on medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, pre-clinical sciences, and much more.

### Other Databases With Psychology Articles

#### **Academic Universe.** (Lexis-Nexis)

Full text articles from medical & health journals, medical & health news sources covering healthcare, and abstracts from MEDLINE.

#### **Annual Reviews**

Critically reviews the most significant primary research literature for 29 focused disciplines within the biological, medical, physical, and social sciences.

#### **GenderWatch**

Full text international journals, magazines, newsletters, regional publications, special reports and conference proceedings devoted to women's and gender issues.

#### **Digital Dissertations**

Contains information about doctoral dissertations and master's theses from 1861 to the present.
